June 2, 2020	Lowe's Hamilton 1945, Barton Street E, Hamilton, Ontario	The associate last worked on May 31. We were informed of their condition on June 2. We closed the store on June 2 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store. The store reopened on June 3.
June 4, 2020	L'Entrepôt RONA Mascouche 175, montée Masson, Mascouche, Québec	The associates last worked on May 21. We were informed of their condition on June 4. Although the diagnosed associates were not at the store during the period when there was a risk of contagion, we still proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken.
June 5, 2020	Lowe's York 1300 Castlefield Avenue, York, Ontario	The associate last worked on June 5. We were informed of their condition on June 5. We closed the store on June 5 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store with them before reopening the store on June 6.
June 10, 2020	RONA Sainte-Martine 680, boulevard St-Jean- Baptiste, Sainte-Martine, Québec	The associate last worked on June 8. We were informed of their diagnostic on June 10. We closed the store on June 10 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store with them before reopening the store on June 11.

We closed the store on June 11 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store with them before reopening the store on June 12.
June 12, 2020	Réno-Dépôt Marché Central 1011 rue du Marché Central, Montréal, Québec	The associate last worked at the store on June 11, i.e. before we proceeded with an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises in the evening of June 11. We were informed of their condition on June 12. The local public health authorities are aware of the situation and the store remains open.
June 14, 2020	RONA Surrey (Fleetwood) 16659, Fraser Highway, Surrey (British Columbia)	The associate last worked on June 9. We were informed of their diagnostic on June 14. We closed the store on June 14 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store with them before reopening the store on June 15.
June 15, 2020	Réno-Dépôt Marché Central 1011 rue du Marché Central, Montréal, Québec	The associate last worked on June 12. We were informed of their diagnostic on June 15. We closed the store on June 15 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises. We also duly notified the local public health authorities of the situation and discussed the measures taken at the store with them before reopening the store on June 16.
June 21, 2020	RONA Pont-Viau 164, boulevard des Laurentides, Laval, Québec	The associate last worked on June 18. We were informed of their diagnostic on June 21. We closed the store on June 21 and proceeded to an extensive cleaning and disinfecting of the premises.
